



Piper Freedom of Flight Award 2019 Scholarship Guidelines

Piper Aircraft, Inc. announces the 2019 ***Piper Freedom of Flight Award Program***. Under the Program, one (1) \$1,000 scholarship which is renewable for up to four (4) years will be awarded to a senior attending a local high school. Children of Piper employees are strongly encouraged to apply.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- Applicant must have at least one parent employed within Indian River County.
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0, and must maintain at least a GPA of 2.5 GPA while in school following high school graduation in order to continue to receive the annual scholarship disbursements.
- Must have a total family annual income under \$80,000.
- Must be accepted to attend a 2 or 4 year college or technical school.
- Applicants will submit an essay (maximum of 600 words) describing how volunteer or community service has shaped who you are today and what community service has taught you. Also, discuss in your essay about any challenges or obstacles you have dealt with and overcome in life and how this will help you succeed in college and beyond.
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the school that the student will be attending. Payment will be made in September 2019 for the ***first semester of the student's first year***. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to Piper Aircraft an invoice for first semester's tuition and fees, student ID number, college information and where to mail scholarship payment.
- For each year remaining on the four year scholarship, funds will be paid directly to the school that the student is attending and will be made in the fall semester. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to Piper Aircraft their college transcript reflecting the grades earned as well as an invoice for fall semester's tuition and fees, student ID number, college information and where to mail scholarship payment.
- Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program. ***Piper Aircraft strongly suggests that each high school present this opportunity to the strongest applicants that match this program's guidelines.*** Application deadline is **March 29, 2019** by 4:00 p.m. Late applications will not be accepted.
