Requirements for this position:

- Must be 18 or older by August 3 of 2020

- Must meet enrollment requirements for Indian River State College

Apprentices will get hands on experience building airplanes, but also learn about the management and organizational aspects of Piper Aircraft. They will take relevant courses at Indian River State College, which will count towards an Associate Degree.
