REQUIREMENTS FOR THIS POSITION:

- Pass all Piper hiring requirements
- Must be 18 or older by 8/1/2022
- Must have high school diploma or GED
- Must be eligible to work in the US
- Must meet enrollment requirements for Indian River State College
- Must meet all apprenticeship program requirements and pass all classes and course work

Apprentices will get hands on experience building airplanes, but also learn about the management and organizational aspects of Piper Aircraft. They will take relevant courses at Indian River State College, which will count towards an Associate Degree.
